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Certificate Course in ADVOCACY SKILL 2021-22

Course Report

The certificate course in '**Advocacy skills**' is a bridging course to fill up the gap between theory & practice of Law. The course was completed in more than 30 sessions. The course components are as below-

- Drafting of proposed legal remedy, Notice, suit, complaint, dispute, criminal, writ, and appeal.
- Conduct of proceedings upto trial- framing of issues, duty of court, lawyer's duties, burden of proof, recasting of issues.
- Evidence- Preparation of chief; witness preparation for cross, critical appraisal of evidence, strategies, dealing with expert/ expert evidence
- Evidence of opposite party- collections and cross checking of information, preparation of cross examination of opposite party, actual conduct of cross examination, laws involved skill sets required, information assimilation and synchronisation.
- Final arguments- Analysis of facts and evidence, application of law, actual pleading of one's case by advancing oral argument skills involved including repartee skills; actual performance, importance of language, choice of appropriate words, vocabulary, mannerism, etiquettes, oratory skills.
- Appeal, Preparation, analysis of facts and judgements, drafting of appeal, language, criticism of judgement and mannerism involved in it.
- Writs- Original side, appellate side, SLP, PIL- Laws involved in manner of pleading, practice and procedure- language, mannerism, conducting before HC and SC. Review, reference, curative petitions, scope, limitations, relevant laws, case laws, and development of overall acumen.

- With special reference to criminal practice- Bails, Anticipatory bails, cancellation of bail-writing application, pleadings and conduct before courts, diagnosis as a backbone, strategies involved.
- Trial and cross examination- cross examination of expert witness.
- Professional ethics- Do's and don'ts conduct of an advocate
