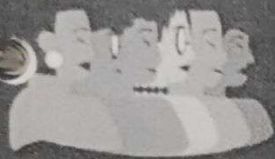

Webinar Report 2021-22

Webinar on gender Sensitization with special reference to LGBTQ+ Community

Gender Sensitization is a basic requirement to understand the sensitive needs of a particular gender. With an aim to create awareness amongst our students we organised a Webinar on Gender Sensitisation with special reference to LGBTQ+. We had a wide range of dynamic speakers for the webinar.

Shri Bindumadhav Khire, Founder, Bindu Queer Rights Foundation addressed the students on "Conceptual aspects of LGBTQ+ and Medico Legal issues surrounding LGBTQ+". He explained in a very engaging way the difference between Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transsexual and Queers. A wide variety of terms are currently used to address and refer to persons of diverse sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression or sex characteristics

LESBIAN: Usually refers to a woman who has a romantic and/or sexual orientation toward women.

GAY: Used in some cultural settings to represent men who are attracted to men in a romantic, erotic and/or emotional sense.

BISEXUAL or BI: A person who experiences sexual, romantic, physical, and/or spiritual attraction to more than one gender.

TRANSGENDER: A person whose sense of personal identity or gender does not correspond to the sex they were assigned at birth, or does not conform to gender stereotypes.

QUEER: a multi-faceted word that is used in different ways and means different things to different people.

Shri Pallav Patankar, Director Partnerships - Avegen Pvt Ltd., Mumbai shared his thoughts on "Social Perspectives Surrounding LGBTQ+. He shared his views on how Family's acceptance plays a vital role in making other genders feel positive and more

importantly "inclusive". Some parents are open and accepting. Others may not understand what it means to be lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, or questioning. Some parents may believe

stereotypes about LGBTQ people. Telling one's family can be a big decision. Help and support are out there if one needs it. Also parents, family members, and friends should be taught to know what being LGBTQ means.

Ms. Sonali Dalvi, Transgender Activist and Social worker, Pune spoke on "Violence faced by Trans Community". Her speech revealed how Transgender community face violence on a day to day basis. She expressed her heartfelt concern over not having

separate hospitals, beds and even toilets. She made an emotional appeal to everyone to treat them as human beings and lead a dignified life. Many communities accept LGBTQ people without bias. But some communities do not. For adults and teens, hate crimes, job discrimination, and housing discrimination can be serious problems. For teens, bullying in school can also be a problem.

The vilification of LGBTQ members has in fact become a norm, with doctors, instead of treating the ailment, often sexually harass or abuse a transgender, or worse, condemn the "unnatural sexual preferences" of the person. They require specific protection responses and may also require specific forms of humanitarian assistance.

Asst. Prof. Bhavna Wanre, School of Law, Presidency University, Bengaluru addressed

on the issue "Reproductive Health and Reproductive Rights- A Trans Perspective". A transgender man is someone with a male gender identity and a female sex assigned at birth. A transgender woman is someone with a female gender identity and a male sex assigned at birth. Transgender persons have different healthcare needs. Even though the right to gender identity and the right to sexual and reproductive healthcare are basic human rights, trans-masculine persons are forced to choose between one or the other. Many trans-men delay transitioning just so that they can have children.

Role of law is important in both securing and inhibiting the rights of transgender persons. The term "reproductive justice" was centred around freedom from state interference and reliant on the right to privacy.

Since POCSO does not recognise sexual activity below the age of 16 years, trans-adolescents who may need abortion services or reproductive healthcare will necessarily have to approach the police. Needing to go to the police is in itself a limitation of access. Even trans-affirming doctors will hesitate to provide care since there is a risk of criminal penalties which may be imposed on them. Adoption also do not consider transgender persons within their scope. Hence there is need of reform

It was a wonderful presentation full of qualitative academic research. The Webinar was attended by approximately 70 students. It enhanced the knowledge about the LGBTQ community and about their rights and ailments suffered by them. It is necessary to know about them in order to understand them. This is the first step in working towards their betterment.
