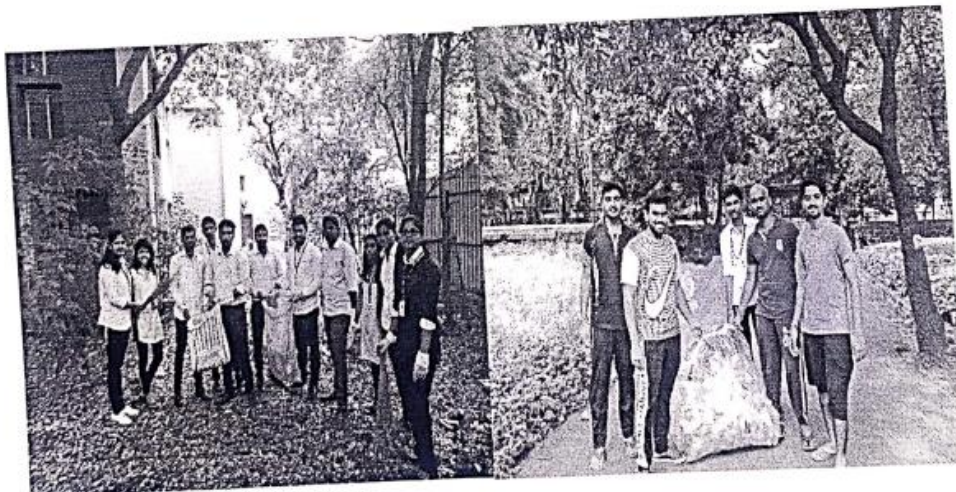


Cleanliness Awareness Drive in Vadarvadi and Cleanliness Drive and Zero Garbage awareness campaign
