Emerging Sustainable Approach to Climate Change

Government of India in December, 1982, established an Environmental Information System (ENVIS) as a plan programme under the EI Division of the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change. ENVIS Centre on Environmental Law and Policy at National Law School of India University is established in September, 2017 at NLSIU campus as ENVIS focal point under the aegis of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India. It was the first time that the Centre reached outside the State of Karnataka and accepted our invitation to conduct Orientation Programme on 'Emerging Sustainable Approaches to Climate Change' in collaboration with DES SNFLC. More than 150 participants were registered from UG & PG. Students and faculties from Environmental Science were large in number along with the law students and faculties. There were four sessions conducted under this programme. First session was on 'Climate Change – An Overview of Global Negotiations' delivered by the Mr. Sourabh Ubale, Programme Officer & Faculty, DES SNFLC. Followed by two sessions one on 'Climate Change – The Human Rights Dimensions' and one on 'Climate Change – The ILO Perspective- An insight into the Green Jobs Concept' by Dr. Anuja S., Coordinator, ENVIS Centre on Environmental Law and Policy and Faculty at National Law School of India University, Bengaluru. The last session was conducted on 'Climate Change-The Emerging need for a Social Corporate Responsibility in India' by Dr. Shyamtanu Pal, Faculty, School of Law, Christ (Deemed

to be University), Bengaluru. The convenors of the programme were Dr. R. Venkata Rao, Vice-Chancellor of NatAional Law School of India University, Bengaluru along with the Principal of DES SNFLC Dr. Rohini Honap.

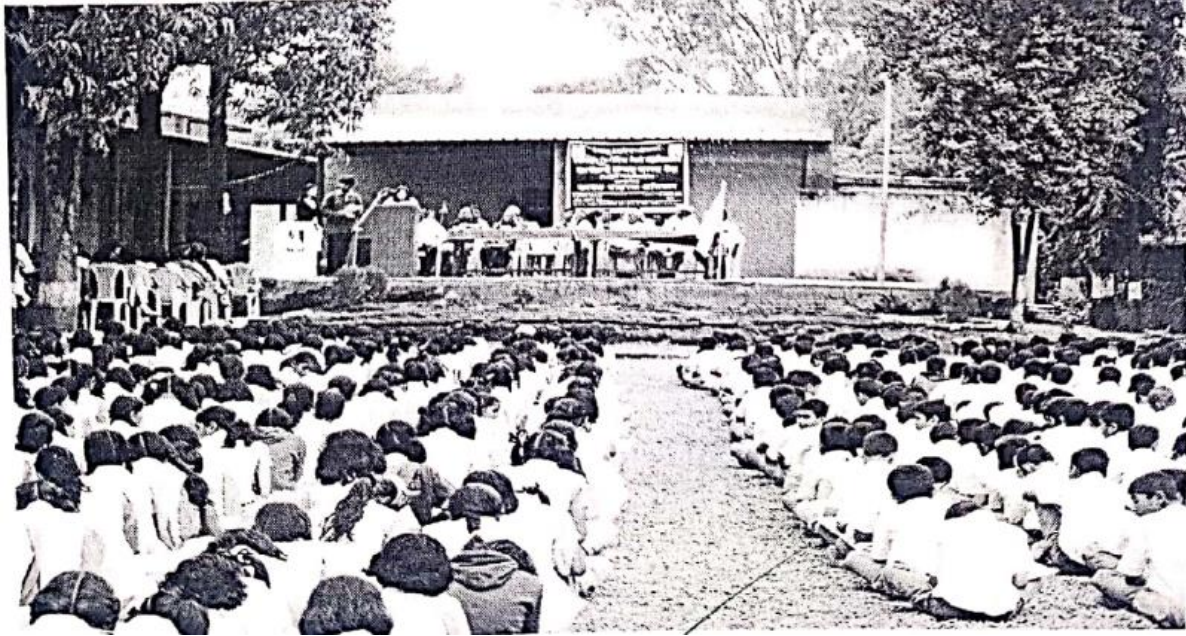

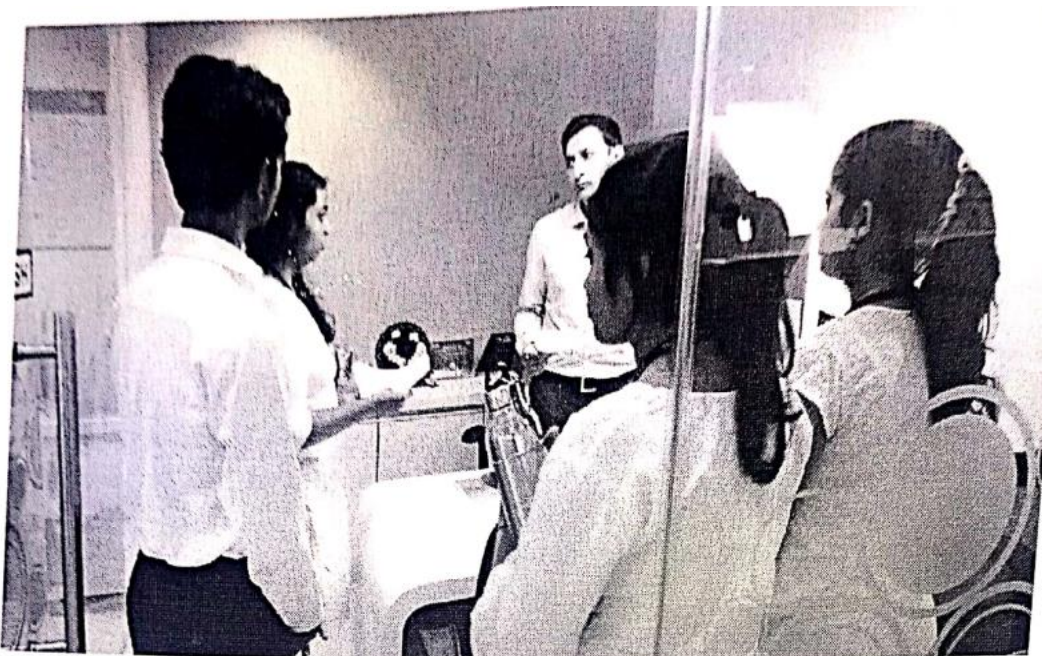
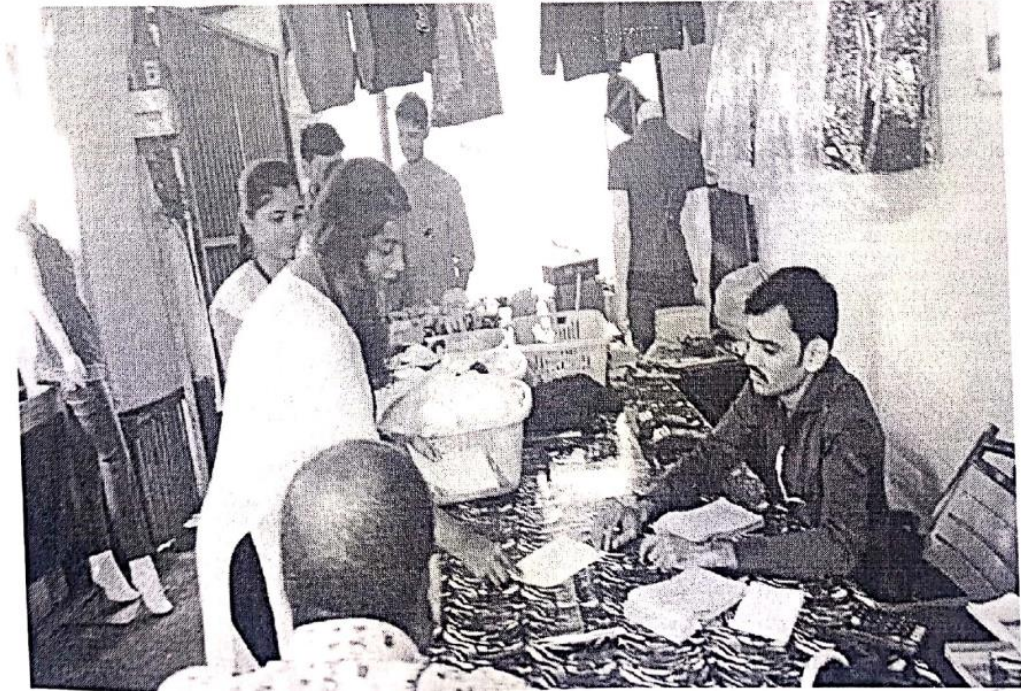
legal aid camp at village chas tal: khed Dist; Pune
